

What is Ireland doing about energy cost competitiveness?

Ireland has committed to developing metrics of energy cost competitiveness as outlined in the Government's White Paper on Ireland's Transition to a Low Carbon Energy Future 2015-2030. We have developed average electricity and natural gas prices for business and households. These are based on the EU Electricity and Gas Price Regulation statistics.

What is the cheapest electricity bill in Ireland?

Yuno Energy have the cheapest estimated annual bill at EUR1,299.52. The average electricity bill in Ireland is EUR1,817.12 for a 24hr urban standard meter. Electricity Prices Ireland: How Much is a Unit of Electricity? In August 2025, the average unit price for a standard, 24-hour urban electricity meter in Ireland is 35.14c per kWh, inclusive of VAT.

How much does electricity cost in Ireland?

In September 2025, the average price of electricity in Ireland per unit is 34.63c per kWh. This is based on a standard, 24hr urban rate comparing all providers with VAT included. Community Power has the cheapest unit rate per kWh at 28.80c including VAT. The average estimated electricity bill in Ireland is EUR1,817.12 including VAT and other charges.
