

# Average MW scale storage system price per 2MW in Italy

How much does a 2MW battery storage system cost?

In total, the cost of a 2MW battery storage system can range from approximately \$1 million to \$1.5 million or more, depending on the factors mentioned above. It is important to note that these are only rough estimates, and the actual cost can vary depending on the specific requirements and characteristics of each project.

How much does energy storage cost?

**\*\*Battery Cost\*\***: The battery is the core component of the energy storage system, and its cost accounts for a significant portion of the total cost. As of 2024, the cost of lithium-ion batteries, which are widely used in energy storage, has been declining. On average, the cost of lithium-ion battery cells can range from \$0.3 to \$0.5 per watt-hour.

How many GW of battery storage will Italy have by 2050?

The remaining 3-4 GW is expected to come from utility-scale systems. By 2050, Italy aims to achieve 30-40 GW of storage capacity. There are significant regional differences in the adoption of battery storage systems across the country.

How much does battery storage cost in Europe?

As we've explored, the current costs range from EUR250 to EUR400 per kWh, with a clear downward trajectory expected in the coming years.

How much does a battery storage system cost?

The cost of the BMS can account for about 5% to 10% of the total battery storage system cost. For a 2MW system, if we assume a BMS cost ratio of 8%, and the total system cost excluding the BMS is \$800,000 (as calculated for the battery cost above), then the cost of the BMS would be  $\$800,000 * 0.08 = \$64,000$ .
