

# Average residential ESS price per 3MW in Sweden

How much does electricity cost in Sweden?

The average price of electricity in Sweden, in June of 2024, has been 0.2434 EUR per kilowatt hour. Electricity price has increased EUR 0.0253 kWh, 11.6% since the previous semester. Meanwhile, the average price of electricity without taxes in Sweden in that period was EUR 0.1571 per kilowatt hour, compared to EUR 0.1407 kWh in the previous semester.

How much did electricity cost in Sweden in 2023?

In 2023, electricity prices were significantly lower than in 2022 in all Swedish bidding zones. On average, the system price was 64 ¢/kWh in 2023, which was a decrease of 55 per cent compared with the previous year's prices. In the four Swedish bidding zones SE1, SE2, SE3 and SE4, the average prices were between 46 and 74 ¢/kWh.

What factors affect electricity prices in Sweden?

Electricity prices in Sweden are influenced by various factors including the transition to renewable energy sources, limitations in the electricity network's capacity, and the prices in neighboring countries as Sweden is part of a common electricity market with the rest of Europe.

Does Sweden have a retail electricity market?

The Swedish retail electricity market has been open to competition since 1996, and prices are set by market participants. There are approximately 5.6 million electricity customers in Sweden, of which approximately 4.7 million are household customers.

Where are electricity prices regulated in Sweden?

In Sweden, the electricity market is divided into four price areas to better regulate electricity prices. These areas are as follows: Luleå (SE1): Northern parts of Sweden, including Luleå and Norrbotten. Sundsvall (SE2): Central parts of Sweden, including Sundsvall, Gäddede, and Dalarna.

Can I Choose my electricity supplier in Sweden?

Whatever your reasons, the good news is that in Sweden, you have the freedom to choose your electricity supplier. When you move into a new home in Sweden, you're automatically connected to the local electricity grid, and your electricity is supplied by a default company.
