How much does a roof-mounted photovoltaic system cost in Italy?

A standard 7kWh system, suitable for a three-bedroom home, usually costs around EUR8,500. This investment typically includes the battery unit (EUR4,000-6,000), inverter (EUR1,500-2,000), and installation labour (EUR1,000-1,500).
