How much does government procurement cost in New Zealand?

New Zealand's government procurement, valued at roughly \$40 billion NZD annually, opens doors for businesses of all sizes. The centralized platform, Government Electronic Tenders Service (GETS), publishes opportunities and categorizes them as low-value (under \$50,000 NZD), medium-value (\$50,000-\$250,000 NZD), and high-value (over \$250,000 NZD).

What is the government electronic tenders service (gets)?

The Government Electronic Tenders Service (GETS) is a free service. It supplies information about New Zealand government contract opportunities and includes any replacement e-procurement system. GETS promotes open, transparent and fair competition. MBIE manages GETS on behalf of the New Zealand government.

How do government agencies support economic growth in New Zealand?

They support economic growth through government procurement, and they tighten the rules of engagement on panel contracts. Government agencies must publish their procurement policies and consider how they can create opportunities for New Zealand businesses.

How can government procurement deliver better public value to New Zealand?

Delivering better public value through government procurement should include securing economic benefits to New Zealand. A list of matters agencies can consider for delivering economic benefit can be found in Rule 8. Agencies should consider which matters are most appropriate for the procurement and likely to deliver the benefits sought.

How can government agencies create opportunities for New Zealand businesses?

Government agencies must publish their procurement policies and consider how they can create opportunities for New Zealand businesses. The procurement function is an agency's key market interface, providing intelligence and insights on market dynamics and emerging trends, as well as external feedback on investment projects.

Which services are covered by New Zealand's commitments?

New Zealand's commitments are applied to all goods, all construction services, and all other services except for research and development, public health services, education services and welfare services above the specified thresholds to the following entities:
